Tips for reading Dikkie Dik aloud





Use the pictures on the side to play a searching game. Ask your child: 'Where's the snail?', 'Can you find the frog?' and 'Where are the carrots?'. Also try switching roles so your child can say what you should search for.



As well as there being so much to point out and name on the pictures, you should also talk with your child about what's happening. For example, Dikkie Dik and his friends are playing in the laundry room and are being naughty. A cat is climbing in the washing machine, a bucket of water has fallen over and all the laundry is on the floor.

You don't need to keep on asking questions to get your child talking, as they'll also respond if you suddenly look really surprised or start laughing at something. Or if you say, for example, 'Oh, look at that!' or 'Haha, that's so cute!'.



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
